CURRICULUM GOALS

PHONICS

Students will learn all letters of the alphabet by sight and sound. They will learn how to pair the consonants with vowels and read "blends." They will learn how to read and mark vowels in one and two vowel words as well as read the sight words "a," "the," and "I." They will also learn how to read simple sentences and short stories.

MATH

Students will learn simple shapes. They will also learn the primary and secondary colors, as well as black, white, and pink. They will learn to count from one to one hundred by ones. Students will also learn numbers 0-20 by sight and the concept of them. They will be introduced to time, money, and the calendar. In addition, students will learn before and after numbers, the concept of more and less, and addition combinations for the one family.
