WAYS TO PREPARE YOUR CHILD FOR KINDERGARTEN

ACADEMIC SKILLS:

1. Prints first name
2. Counts up to 20 objects
3. Recognizes numbers 0-20 and most letters of the alphabet
4. Can identify the basic sound of most of the letters in the alphabet
5. Has proper pencil grip, uses scissors appropriately, draws recognizable figures, and traces well

SELF-CARE SKILLS:

1. Dresses self (coat, shoes, buttons, zips)
2. Uses bathroom independently
3. Cleans up after self
4. Blows and wipes own nose

SOCIAL SKILLS:

1. Shares and takes turns
2. Follows simple multistep directions
3. Plays and listens to others
4. Understands appropriate physical contact
5. Attempts to problem solve independently
6. Cooperates with adults and peers

EMOTIONAL READINESS:

1. Able to contain emotions
2. Tries new things
3. Interacts with others

CURRICULUM GOALS

PHONICS

Students will learn all letters of the alphabet by sight and sound. They will learn how to read and mark vowels in one and two vowel words as well as read a few sight words. They will also learn how to read simple sentences, and short stories. In addition, they will learn to recognize and read 50 special phonetic sounds.

MATH

Students will learn how to count to 100 by 1's, 2's, 5's, and 10's. They will learn time to the hour and half hour. Students will also learn numbers 0-100 by sight. They will be introduced to patterns, fractions, measurements, 3D shapes, ordinal numbers, as well as positional and comparison numbers. In addition, students will learn how to count coins, read a calendar, and addition combinations for the one through ten family.
